

The City of Biddeford filed a Notice of Intent (NOI) with the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) on July 26, 2013 to obtain coverage under the *Maine General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater from the City of Biddeford's Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems* (MER041021) effective July 1, 2013. Moor's Brook
Dungeon Brook
West Brook

Several small streams tributary to the above

The NOI was filed by July 26, 2013. The NOI and the General Permit are available for public inspection at DEP's Augusta office during normal business hours. A copy may also be examined at the City of Biddeford, Engineering Office in Biddeford, Maine.

Public comment will be accepted until a final administrative action is taken to approve, approve with Conditions, or deny this application.
