

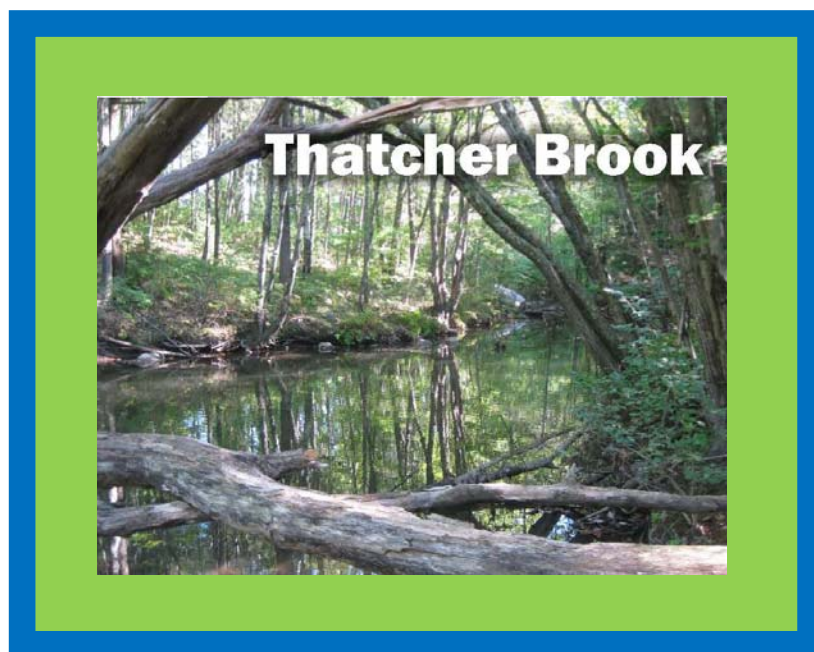
Watershed Community Meeting

Thatcher Brook has been determined by the Maine Department of Environmental Protection to be an impaired stream. At some of the sampling stations in the watershed, it did not meet water quality standards. Collaborators on this project include the City of Biddeford, Town of Arundel, York County Soil & Water Conservation District, Maine DEP, and GZA GeoEnvironmental, Inc.
