REMINDER: DOWNTOWN PERMIT PARKING IS IN EFFECT



The City of Biddeford's permit parking system is now in effect.

If you have purchased a monthly permit, your license plate number has been registered into the kiosk already. You may park in your assigned lot without entering any information into the kiosk

If you will be using a municipally-owned parking lot for short-term parking, you must enter your license plate number into a parking kiosk, select the amount of time that you will need to park, and complete your purchase with a credit or debit card. Your car will be automatically registered into the enforcement system, and you will not need to display a ticket or receipt in your window. The introductory hourly rate for short-term parking is \$1 per hour.

Additionally, parking permits can be purchased through a free mobile app called **WayToPark**. The app is a convenient option to help you buy and extend your parking permit while on-thego. Once you set up an account and store a payment method, you will simply need to find your location on the map, enter the hours you plan to park, and confirm your purchase.

There will be a \$50 fine for parking in a downtown municipal lot without a permit.

Downtown Committee Meeting Update

At their November 26 meeting, the Downtown Committee established the Yellow Lot (Downtown Lot) as a reserved lot for short-term parking only. The first hour of parking in this lot will be free of charge, and additional time in the lot can be purchased for the hourly rate.

The Downtown Committee also removed the restrictions on the number of long-term parking permits that can be sold for each lot, allowing permits to be sold until the lot reaches capacity. The City Council had originally established a cap on long-term parking permits in the parking ordinance, requiring that no more than 65% of available spaces in each lot could be sold for monthly parking.
